The joint effort project between the Illinois Tollway and IDOT is described as the I-294 / I-57 Interchange project and is located in the cities of Midlothian and Harvey, Illinois. The first phase of the multi-year project will create access from northbound I-57 to northbound I-294 and is being let as Contract #I-12-4066. The scope of work for this project includes widening and/or reconstructing pavement along I-57 Street and new ramps onto I-294 and drainage improvements. This work will include excavation for pavement removal, storm sewer, drainage structures, pavement construction, ditch grading and embankment grading due to the I-57 widening and new I-57 / I-294 ramps.
